


## Sudden Oak Death Zone of Infestation Revised January, 2005

Zone of Infestation

This map provides a general depiction of Sudden Oak Death areas as of January, 2005. *Phytophthora ramorum* has been isolated and identified from tree or plant samples by laboratory diagnosis. *P. ramorum* is the causal agent of Sudden Oak Death.
