1 On Monday, September 21, 2015, at approximately 9:29 AM, I was meeting with John PINCH and
 2 Parker MILLS to take them to their residence at 8015 High Valley Road, to conduct a follow up
 3 interview for clarification purposes. The following is in summary of what I was told:

 5 Lara MILLS greeted me at the entrance of where they were staying. L. MILLS told me they spoke
 6 with their insurance company who advised them not to talk to me without an attorney present. I told
 7 L. MILLS I understood and told them to contact me once their lawyer was available.

 9 I left the property and approximately three minutes after leaving, P. MILLS called me and asked if I
 10 would be able to escort them to the property to gather some personal items and medications. I told
 11 him yes and returned to where they were.

 13 I escorted P. MILLS in my vehicle with L. MILLS and John PINCH in two separate vehicle following. I
 14 did not talk to P. MILLS about the case and we had casual conversation on the drive to the 8015
 15 High Valley Road property. When we arrived I stayed off the property and waited for them to conduct
 16 their business. P. MILLS took a separate vehicle from the residence at our departure and did not
 17 return with me. I escorted them back out of the road closure and parted ways.

 19 Later in the afternoon I received a call from the MILLS & PINCH attorney, Fred WIESNER. I went to
 20 his location and provided him and his colleagues an escort to the 8015 High Valley Road property. I
 21 stayed off the property at my vehicle and spoke with WIESNER, who told me they would like to
 22 discuss the questions I had for P. MILLS and PINCH prior to me interviewing them. I told him I would
 23 contact CAL FIRE Legal and discuss options with them. I left the area and WIESNER and the private
 24 investigators remained at the property.

 26 I called the WIESNER back later in the evening and told him I did not wish to meet in the morning
 27 and conduct an interview with his clients. I told him I would contact him directly if anything changed.
